
Three game admission tickets and three hockey jerseys from the Vancouver Canucks valued at a total of \$1200.00 received on October 4, 2023 while attending the September 30, 2023 recognition ceremony for the National Day of Truth and Reconciliation.

On November 20, 2023 attended in official capacity as Premier a ceremony celebrating the 2025 Invictus Games which will be hosted in British Columbia. Two game admissions (no commercial value) were received and the Vancouver Canucks providing a private box for attendees of the Invictus Games puck drop and meeting with Duke and Duchess of Sussex.
