PROGRAM SUMMARY

CCPAC supports the work of public accounts committees and legislators across Canada by exchanging information, sharing best practices, and promoting accountability. This year's conference included a roundtable on effective practices across jurisdictions, including committee administration and meeting scheduling, follow-up on audit report recommendations, committee questions, and non-partisanship. Other business sessions examined best practices related to follow-ups, and reviewing public accounts and performance audits in more detail. The importance of cross-party collaboration and leadership and the importance of and approaches to reviewing performance audits were also explored.

- Committee Members increase their understanding of best practices for their role on the Select Standing Committee on Public Accounts.
- Committee staff increase their knowledge and understanding of best practices to support parliamentary committee functions.
